**The World Language Institute will be held on the campus of Villanova University
from Sunday July 15 through Friday July 20 2007.**

About the Institute:

100 World Language teachers will be accepted and provided with a full scholarship for meals, housing, program of study, materials and two graduate credits (and/or 60 Act # 48 credit hours).

Each year a statewide Steering Committee of World Language and curriculum specialists update and develop the “**focus**” of the Institute program. The instruction will center on small-group learning experiences produced, presented and facilitated by experts.

Activities will focus on:

- **A more polished second year theme for 2007 “Assessment in Light of the PA Academic Standards for World Languages / Classical Languages and the National Standards for Foreign Languages”**
- Alignment of standards-based instruction and assessment
- Utilization of technology to support and globalize learning
- Comparisons of FLES, FLEX, and IMMERSION
- **A True World Language Connections Standard** that demonstrates an integrated curriculum where proficiency levels in literacy and mathematics (Assessment Anchors) will be increased throughout the schools of Pennsylvania.
